



COYOTES ICE ENSEMBLE 2009 - 2010

- Rehearsal Day/Time:** **Wednesday 5:30 – 7:00 PM**
45 minutes on-ice followed by 30 minutes off-ice. See below for exact dates.
- Dates:** **September 2, 2009 – June 27, 2010 (Dates listed on back)** Additional rehearsals will be scheduled. Some are listed below while others will be determined after the first of the year. These rehearsals may be scheduled on days other than Wednesday. Season concludes June 27.

- Performances & Competitions:** **Ice Den Annual Show, June 10 - 12, 2010 (tentative dates)**
National/International TOI in Troy, Ohio June 24 – 27, 2010
- Director & Assistant Director:** **Nancy Pluta & Miki Stevens**
- Level Requirements:** **Currently passed Freeskate 6 by Aug. 30, 2009 and Passed Pre-Preliminary Moves by Jan. 31, 2010. It is mandatory that team members skate one lesson per week with a private coach.**
- Fees:** **\$475.00** – Payable to Coyotes Ice, LLC, includes all practices and coaching fees. **Plus a separate fee of \$75.00** – Payable to Coyotes Ice, LLC for the team costume & prop maintenance. **These fees do not include the purchase or making of costumes & props*, competition fees*, or travel expenses.** All travel expenses are the responsibility of the skater.
- Discounts Available:** Participants joining both the Ensemble and Synchro teams receive a 10% discount. Returning members will be awarded a \$50 certificate towards the new season. Certificates will be presented at the clinic on August 29.
- Payment Terms:** **Cash or Check – Payment in full at time of registration.**
Credit Card - due in full at time of registration; **or**, registration fee may be split into two (2) equal payments. **First payment of \$237.50 will be charged at time of registration; second payment of \$237.50 will automatically be charged on November 1, 2009. Maintenance fee of \$75 must be paid in full at time of registration. Credit card # must be provided on the registration form for payment plan option. Post-dated checks will not be accepted.**

COMMITMENT REQUIREMENTS

By applying for a position on the Coyotes Ice Ensemble Team, participation in all practice sessions, performances and competitions is mandatory. Team members must skate as directed. The Head Coach/Assistant Coach understands that absences may be necessary due to other skating commitments, illnesses or family commitments; however, any skater missing more than two (2) practices may be changed to a substitute team member. ***It is the responsibility of the team member to notify the Head Coach/Assistant Coach of any and all scheduling conflicts at least one (1) week in advance.*** *Parents are required to participate in fundraising activities to cover costs such as the purchase or making of costumes & props, and competition fees.

MANDATORY DRESS CODE

Skaters must wear all black skating attire (beige tights are acceptable). Girls' hair must be tied back in a bun or a ponytail and skate laces tucked in. If a skater is not dressed appropriately, they will be asked to leave the ice.
Off-ice Classes: Skater's must wear tennis shoes.
